The IAC are a valued partner of the NHS & play a key role in the supply of aseptically prepared injectable medicines. A highly skilled workforce is integral to the delivery of safe, efficient & resilient aseptic services that meet current & future demand. The IAC continually invest in the recruitment, training & retention of an optimal workforce to ensure that the NHS is efficiently supplied with high quality solutions to meet patient-specific treatment needs.



3,931 full-time equivalent (FTE) staff are employed by members of IAC



358% increase in FTE staff who are directly involved in compounding, quality control, final product release & dispensing since 2022. 9.6% of these staff are pharmacists



Members of IAC are investing in people. It takes an average of 28 weeks (from 8 weeks to 72 weeks) to train a new operator to become competent in aseptic manufacturing



On average, **526 compounding operators & technicians** are **trained by IAC each year**, an **increase** of **57%** in 3 years



71 FTE staff are employed by IAC to **provide training** in aseptic manufacturing units, **up 15% since 2022**



IAC members **partner** with local **further education colleges** & use a range of **nationally recognised qualifications** during training of aseptic operators & technicians
